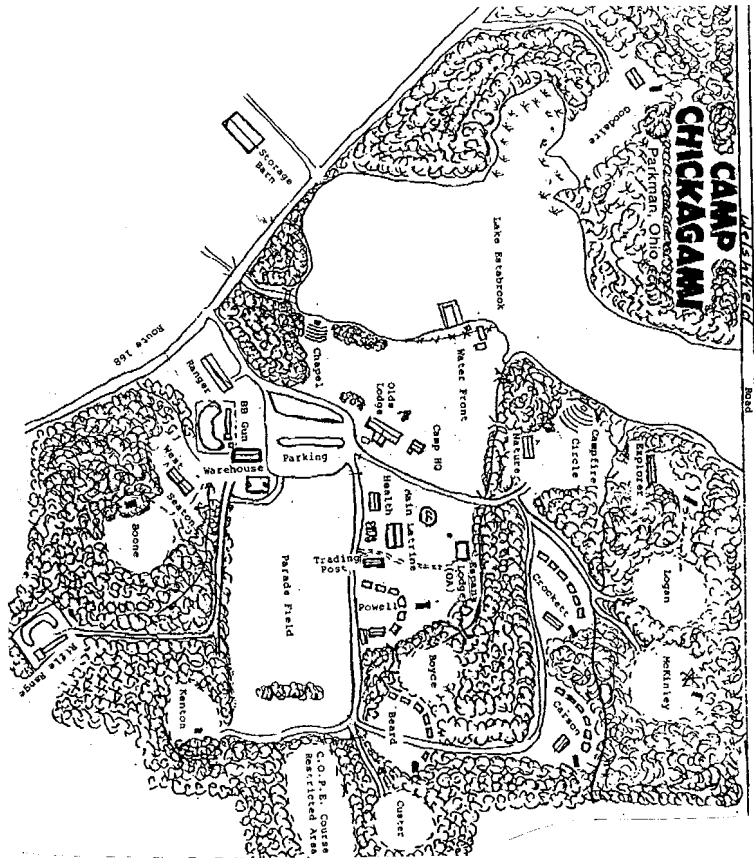

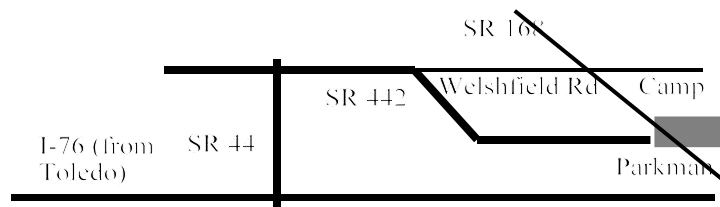
Mike's Chili

| 2 | lb | Lean Ground Beef |
| 1 | large | Sweet Spanish Onion, coarsely diced |
| 4 | Tbl | Water |
| 1 | Tbl | Oil |
| 2 | tsp, each | Salt, Sugar, Cocoa, Ground Cumin, Oregano |
| 2 | tsp, each | Worcestershire Sauce, Tabasco Sauce |
| 4 | tsp | Chili Powder |
| 1 | 28 oz. Can | Canned Whole Tomatoes, crushed |
| 1 | Can | Kidney Beans |

1. Brown beef in oil.
2. Add onion and saute onion until translucent.
3. Add remaining ingredients, except kidney beans, and simmer covered over low heat for 1 hr.
4. Add kidney beans and cook over low heat for 1 hr. uncovered.

Variation 1
